**Starting August 20, NYCDOT will be making safety improvements to 4th Avenue between 15th and 65th streets. These include:**

- Establishing wider curbside lanes to better organize traffic
- Creating more pedestrian space at dozens of medians
- Lengthening and widening left-turn lanes
- Improving morning-commute capacity and reliability between 38th Street and Prospect Avenue
- Adding lanes at bottleneck points to reduce congestion
- Adding loading zones for truck deliveries to reduce double parking

**Implementation begins between 15th and 39th streets on August 20**
